Frederick George Janssen was born on September 16, 1936, to Fred George and Eliza Sophie (Wulff) Janssen in Barnesville, MN. He was raised and lived his entire life on the family farm in Skree Township. Fred was baptized and confirmed in Barnesville. During his youth he was active in 4-H and showed animals at the fair. He attended school in Barnesville and was active in FFA and band during his high school years, graduating in 1954. Following high school, he attended the School of Agriculture at the University of Minnesota, graduating in a year and a half. He returned home to the family farm.


On August 27, 1960, he married Beryl Nadine Jensen at Hawley Lutheran Church. They began their life on the Janssen Farm. Fred was a dedicated farmer who cared for the land and animals all of his life.
