George was a member of Good Shepherd Lutheran Church, serving as Chairman of the Council on several occasions. He also was part of the Men's AMEN choir.

On Sunday November 3rd, George passed away at Sanford Hospital in Fargo, ND at the age of eighty-nine surrounded by his wife and family.

Blessed be the memory of George Sawyer.




