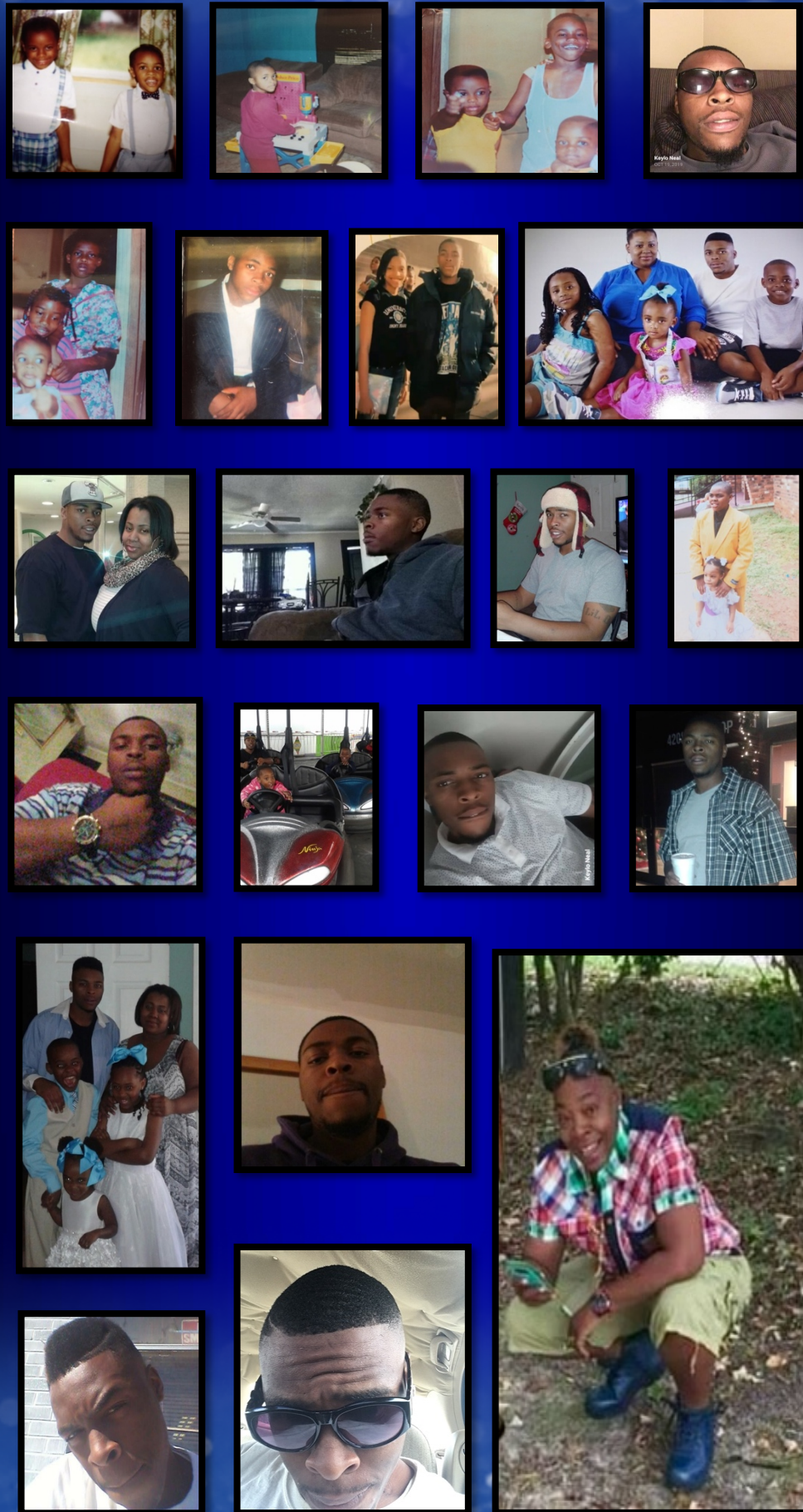


Precious Memories
