

Obituary

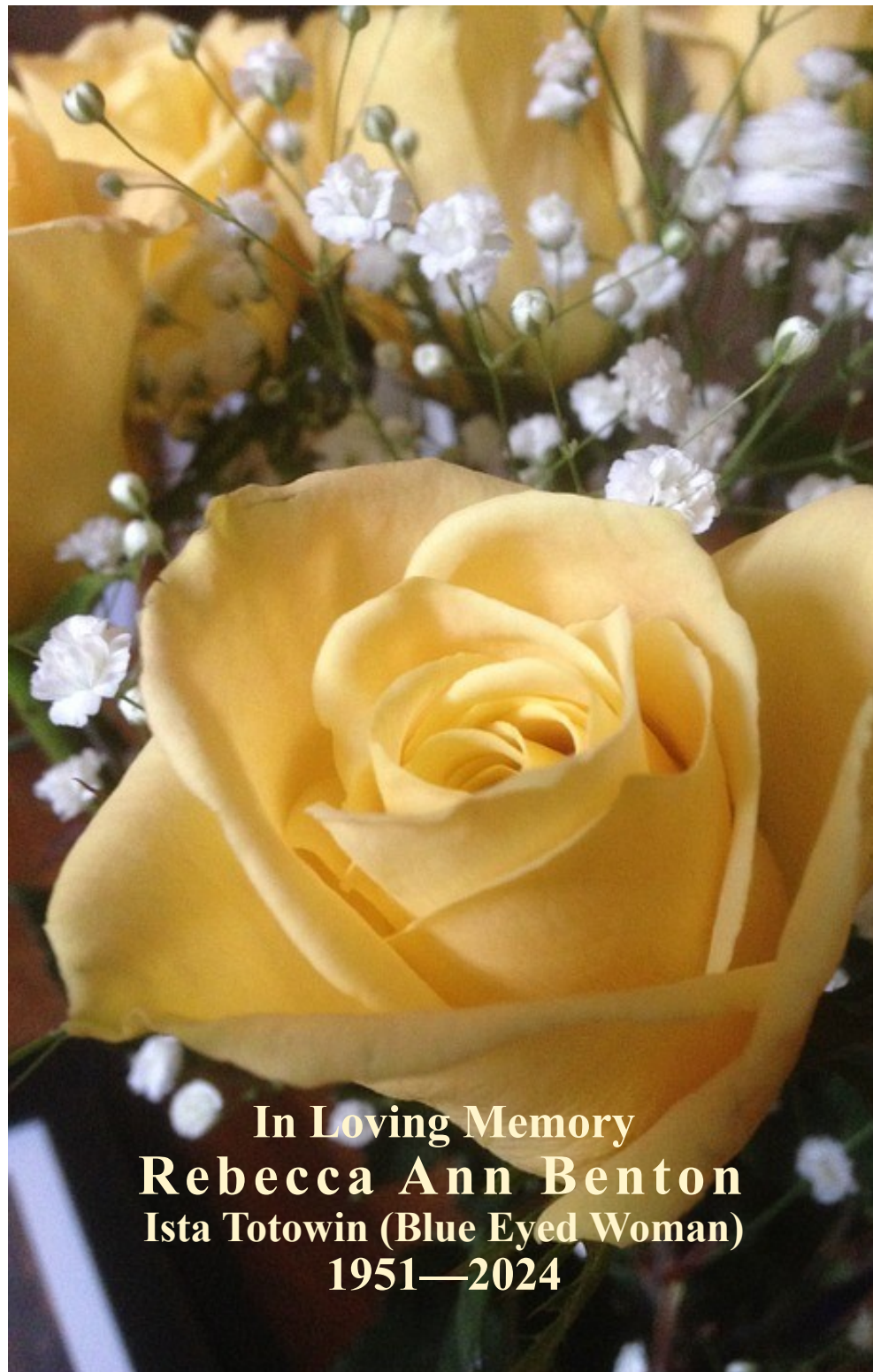
Rebecca 'Becki' Ann Benton, 72, of Hot Springs, SD, passed away May 31, 2024.
