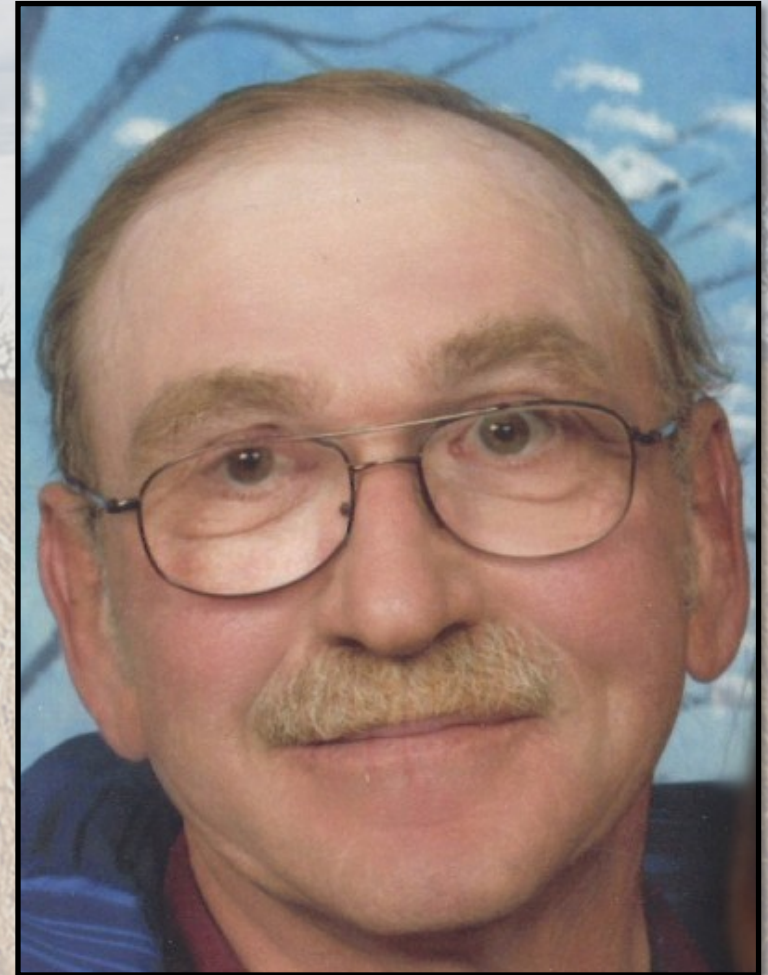
Steve was preceded in death by his parents and his wife Rhonda.
