
On March 31, 1956, Don married Adele Dosland Peterson and together they raised their four children, Bruce, John, Mark, and Susan.


As an avid woodcarver, Don spent endless hours whittling beautiful works of art. Those pieces along with the memories and his stories are the legacies he leaves behind.
