

Broken Chain

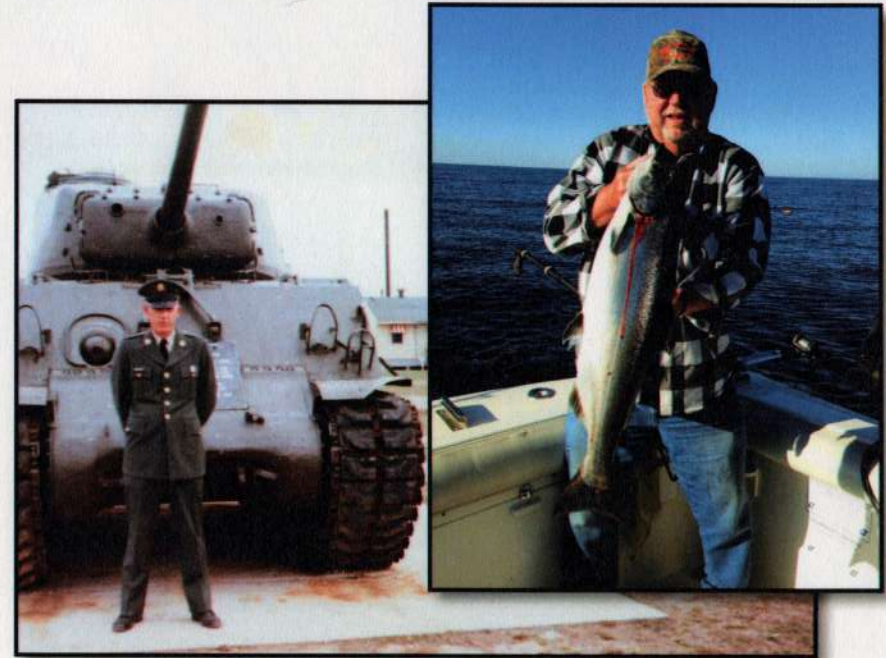
We little knew that morning

the chain will link again.

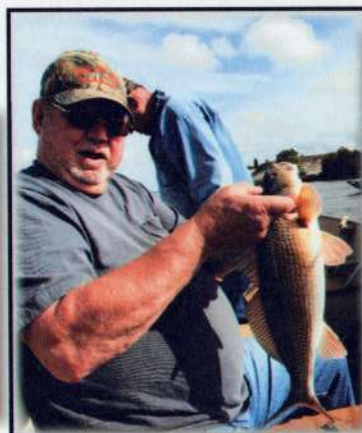
