I am disciplined, physically and mentally tough, trained and proficient in my warrior tasks and drills.



I stand ready to deploy, engage, and destroy, the enemies of the United States of America in close combat.





John "JJ" North was born on July 24, 1987, to Les and Marlene (Banks) North in Landstuhl, Germany near Ramstein Air Base. Growing up as an Air Force brat, John lived all across the United States, spending time in places like Lubbock, Texas; K.I.
