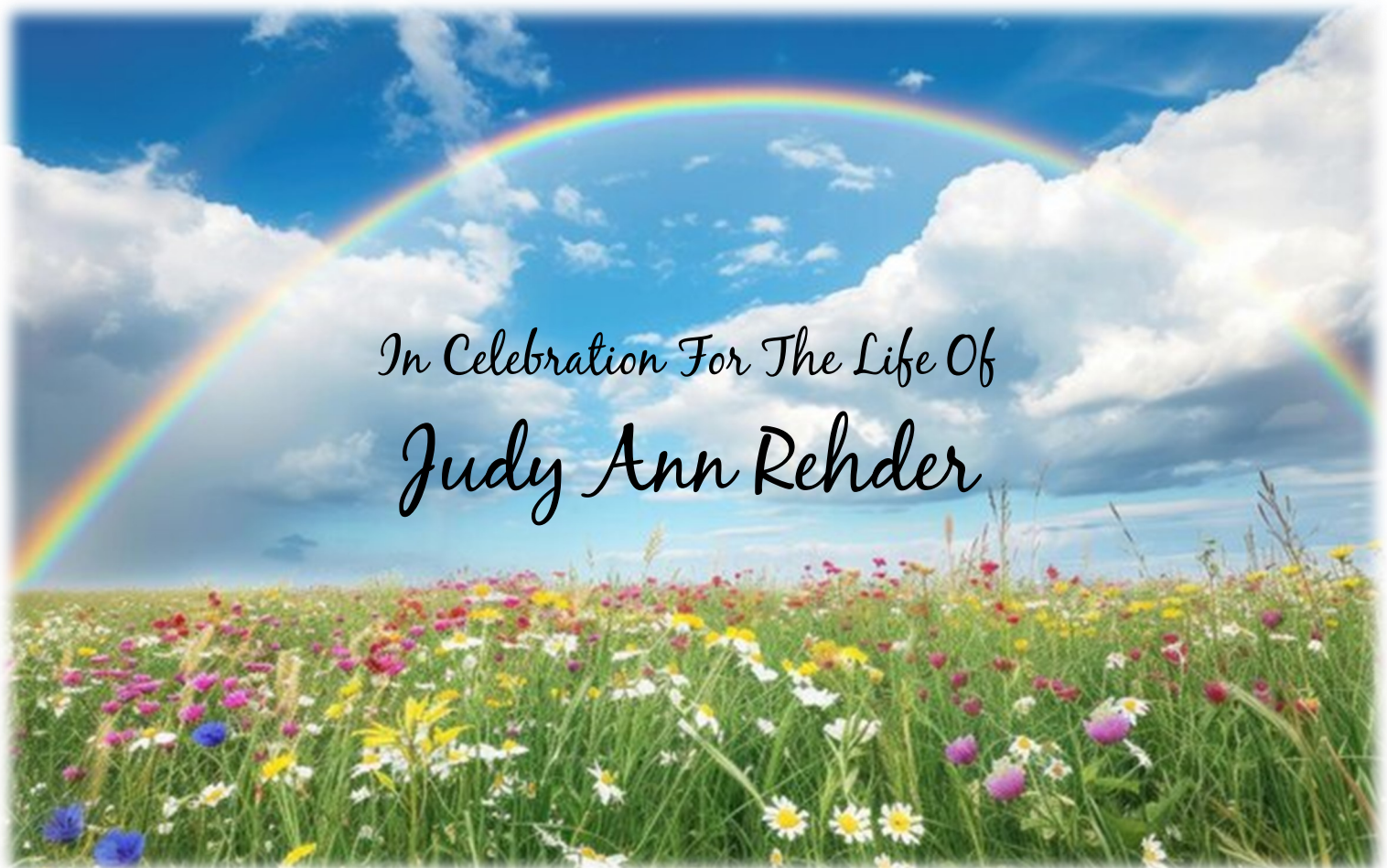
She was preceded in death by her parents Harold and Elsie.
