Jean Annette Johnson was born on June 9, 1936 to Marion J. and Mildred M. (Erickson) Johnson in Alexandria, MN. She grew up near Nelson, MN, and attended school in Alexandria, MN. Following high school, she attended the Swedish Institute of Nursing in the Twin Cities and became a registered nurse.

She was united in marriage to Joseph C. Mickish on October 17, 1959 in Nelson, MN. The couple first made their home in Kansas and later moved to San Mateo, California where they lived until 1971 when they moved to Barnesville. They owned and operated the Standard Station in Barnesville until 1975 when Joe started trucking over the road. Jean worked most of her nursing career at the Good Samaritan Nursing Home in Barnesville.
