REMEMBERING THE LIFE OF...

Bonnie Bring passed away peacefully on Saturday, April 6, 2024, at the age of 81, in the comfort of her home on Lake Lida, under the gentle care of Hospice of the Red River Valley.

Born on January 26, 1943, to Otto and Hazel (Mehus) Satrom, Bonnie grew up near Galesburg, North Dakota, and attended Mayville Teachers College. She was united in marriage with her beloved Lyle Bring on May 29, 1963, and together they farmed and raised their three children near Galesburg. They retired in 1987, and in 1989, relocated to their home on the shores of Lake Lida.

Bonnie spent years as a 4-H leader in Galesburg and as a Sunday School teacher at Stordahl Lutheran Church. She was involved with the Pelican Friends of the Library, the Pass It On ministry, Trinity Quilters and golfing.
