### ***REMEMBERING THE LIFE OF...***

Donald Ishaug, age 88, passed away on June 19, 2025 at his home on Lake Lizzie.

Donald was born January 17, 1937, in his parents' home in rural Pelican Rapids to Henry and Melia (Johnson) Ishaug. He attended elementary school in Norwegian Grove township and graduated from Pelican Rapids High School in 1955. He was baptized and confirmed at North Immanuel Lutheran Church, where he would later serve on the church council for many years.

On May 16, 1959, he married the love of his life and lifelong partner, Ila Mae Hough, at Our Savior's Lutheran Church in Barnesville. Together they raised their four children in and around Pelican Rapids and Barnesville.
