He attended and graduated from Pelican Rapids High School. After graduating, Elroy attended and graduated from the University of Minnesota College of Veterinary Medicine, St. Paul, MN in 1957. Elroy moved back to Pelican Rapids where he became partners with Dick Lyon. He worked as a veterinarian for more than 40 years. Elroy was united in marriage to Rosetta Senn at Trinity Lutheran Church in Pelican Rapids, MN on September 18th, 1954. Rosetta Hexum passed away on March 10, 2014.

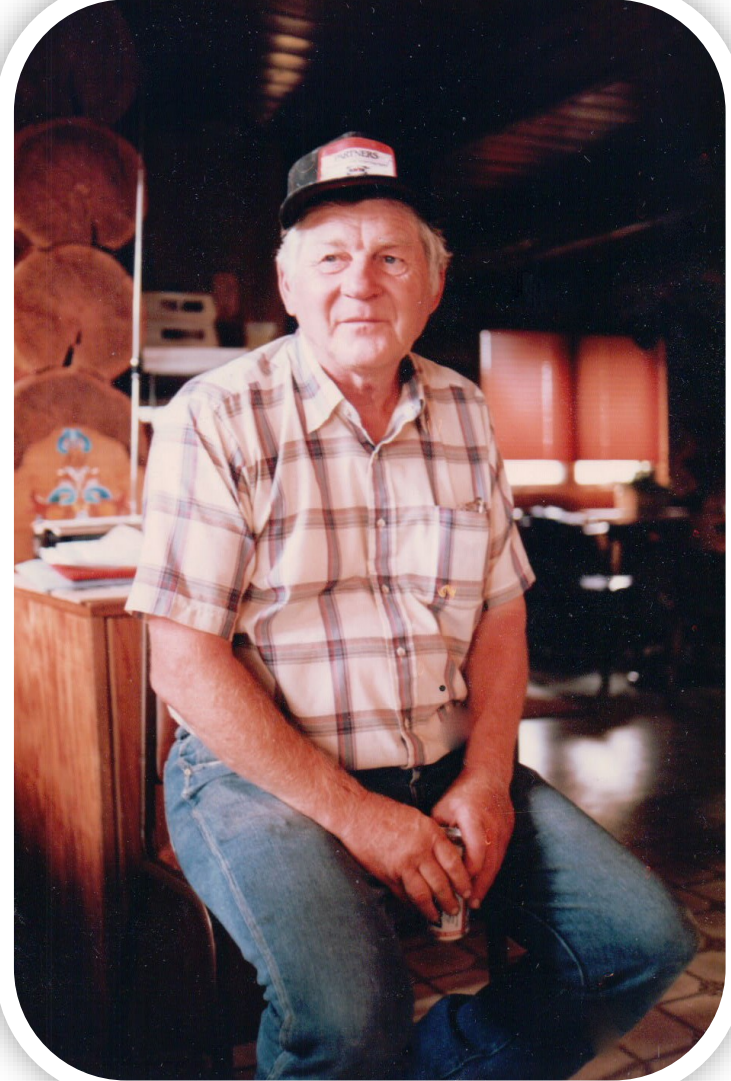
