He is preceded in death by his parents, siblings: Marilyn Gabel, Donald Jackson, Scott Flink, and brother-in-law, Harold Heimark.

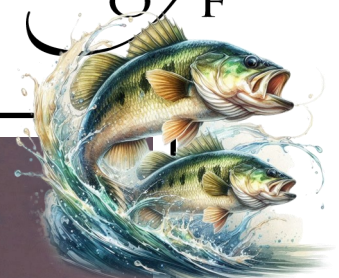
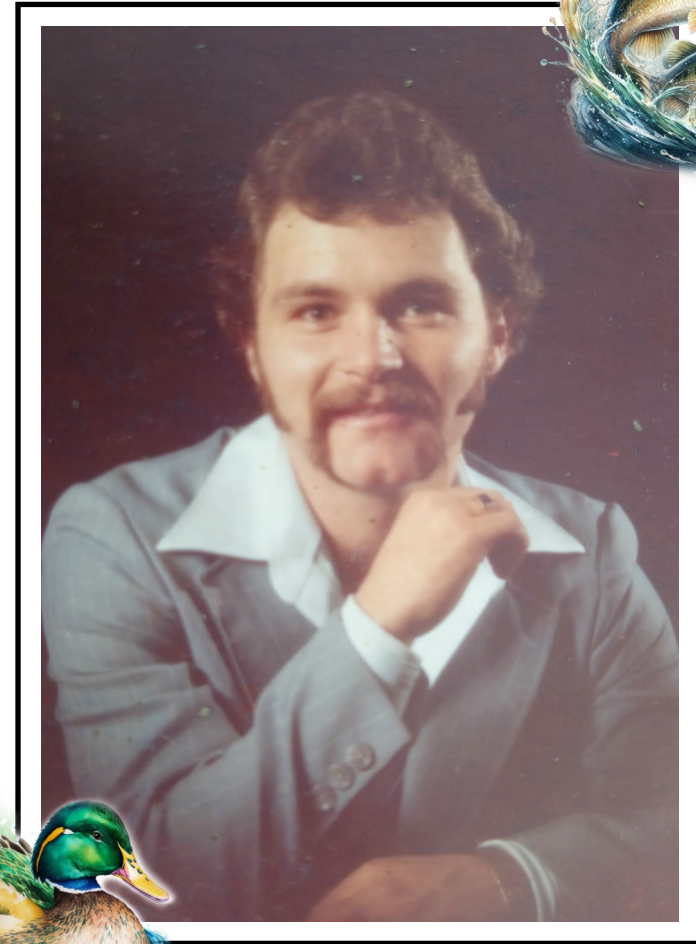
