REMEMBERING THE LIFE OF...

With heavy hearts, we mourn the passing of Mardell Shirley Lindstrom, age 89, of Pelican Rapids, Minnesota, who died on Tuesday, April 2, 2024, under the care of Knute Nelson Hospice and Pelican Valley Senior Living.

Born on July 7, 1934, to Thorsten and Reidun (Olson) Leland in Duluth, Mardell lived a life filled with love and dedication. She was baptized and confirmed at Salem Lutheran Church in Duluth, Minnesota. She went to school and graduated from Denfeld High School in Duluth in 1952. She continued her education at Duluth Business College and worked in banking.
