
Allene Rae (Conlin) Anderson was born on June 17, 1924, to Arthur and Mary (Packard) Conlin in Galena Township, Monterey, Minnesota, on the north end of Cedar Lake. She attended District 102 Country School and later graduated from Trimont High School in 1942. Allene continued her education at Mankato State College and went on to teach in rural schools throughout Rice and Watonwan Counties.
