Randy was preceded in death by his parents; brothers, Bob (Anne), Eugene (Renee), Thomas, and Howard; sisters, Zelda "Jackie" (Frank) Lachowitzer and Vernetta "Babe" (Clarence "Red") Schattschneider; infant sister, Arta Joan; and sister-in-law, Betty.


Randy loved his family and friends and was adored by his nieces and nephews; his passing has left a hole in our hearts.
